

### Current State and Issues (III): Disaster Mitigation and Preparedness for Resilience Building

In the Asia-Pacific region, disasters such as floods, landslides, typhoons/cyclones, earthquakes, tsunamis, storm surges, and volcanic eruptions occur every year. How to protect cultural heritage from these disasters is a common issue for all countries throughout the region.

This Workshop has therefore focused on the Asia-Pacific region for three consecutive years, taking up the current situation and challenges of cultural heritage disaster management. In the final year, the Symposium will revisit the issues identified over the past two years in Emergency Response and Post-disaster Recovery and stimulate discussion on how heritage can be better protected from disasters while contributing to the resilience of societies.
